JOSHUA INTERVENORS' HEARING BRIEF REGARDING THE NLRSD**

Comes now Separate Defendant North Little Rock School District ("NLRSD" or the "District") by and through its counsel, Jack Nelson Jones Jiles & Gregory, P.A., and for its Motion for Extension to Respond to Joshua Intervenors' Hearing Brief Regarding the NLRSD and states as follows:

1. Joshua Intervenors' Hearing Brief Regarding the NLRSD contains 137 paragraphs over the first 40 pages of the brief that require a response from NLRSD.
2. Many of the paragraphs contain factual allegations which necessitate communications with NLRSD employees in order to determine the appropriate responses to the paragraphs.

3. Many NLRSD employees are currently unavailable for communications necessary to formulate NLRSD's response because of the winter break; however, such employees will return to work on January 4, 2010.

4. NLRSD's hearing has been postponed until January 25, 2010, which makes additional time for NLRSD's response possible.
