AFFIDAVIT FOR ARREST WARRANT

The undersigned affiant, being a peace officer under the laws of the State of Texas, duly authorized, and having been duly sworn, on his oath would state as follows:

I.

My name is R. Ochoa and I am an Investigator with the Bexar County Sheriff's Office (BCSO), San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas. Affiant is employed by the Bexar County Sheriff's Office, currently assigned to the Violent Crimes Section, Human Trafficking Unit and has been so employed for 17 years. Affiant has probable cause for said belief by reason of the following facts.

II.

There is in Bexar County, San Antonio, Texas, a person described and located as follows: one Alvin C. Robertson hereinafter referred to as DEFENDANT, who is believed to be living at last known address of 15834 Secret Trail, San Antonio, TX. The DEFENDANT has a date of birth of 07/22/1962 further identified by SID number 0506563.

III.

It is the belief of the affiant that the said DEFENDANT committed the offense of Sex Trafficking of a Minor, Sexual Performance of a Child, and Sexual Assault-Child under Section 20A.02, 43.25, and 22.011 of the Texas Penal Code, an act against the peace and dignity of the State of Texas.

IV.

Your affiant has probable cause for the said belief by reason of the following facts and evidence to believe that DEFENDANT committed Sex Trafficking of a Minor, Sexual Performance of a Child, and Sexual Assault of a Child of said complainant.

Your affiant has read and reviewed all available reports and statements related to BCSO case number 2010-05671. Your affiant bases his belief on the following:

- 1.) Affiant found that on or about March of 2009, a 14 year old female, who is known to me, hereinafter referred to as VICTIM, was kidnapped from [REDACTED] in San Antonio, Texas. The VICTIM then was taken over a course of several days to various locations in Bexar County. One of the locations the VICTIM was taken to was 2650 Thousand Oaks #3302. The DEFENDANT

along with his wife lived at 2650 Thousand Oaks #3302, during this time period.

- 2.) Affiant found that the DEFENDANT and his Wife Conspired with another suspect known to Affiant, to have the VICTIM engage in sexual acts with persons willing to pay money.
- 3.) Affiant found that the VICTIM was taken to a location where a person willing to pay money in exchange for sex with a young girl would be. The DEFENDANT, his wife and another person known to Affiant had the VICTIM change clothes into something more revealing. Then the DEFENDANT's wife and another person known to Affiant transported the VICTIM to where a person willing to pay for sex was waiting.
- 4.) The DEFENDANT on a separate occasion, along with another person known to Affiant, digitally penetrated the VICTIM's vagina and anus. The DEFENDANT committed this act while the VICTIM was showering after just having been forced to have sex with another person known to Affiant in exchange for money.
- 5.) The DEFENDANT further conspired with a person known to Affiant to have the VICTIM engage in sex with another person known to Affiant, then extort money from that person for having had sex with a minor.
- 6.) Affiant respectfully requests issuance of warrants for the arrest of the said Alvin C. Robertson, charging him with the offenses of Sex Trafficking of a Minor, Sexual Performance of a Child, and Sexual Assault of a Child. In Violation of Texas Penal Code Section 20A.02, 43.25, and 22.011 against the peace and dignity of the State of Texas.

Your affiant believes the facts in the above stated paragraphs set forth sufficient evidence to establish probable cause that the offense of Sex Trafficking of a Minor, Sexual Performance of a Child, and Sexual Assault of a Child have been committed by the DEFENDANT.

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, AFFIANT prays that this Court issue a warrant authorizing the Affiant, to any peace officer in the State of Texas, and the Sheriff of Bexar County to take custody of the DEFENDANT, Alvin C. Robertson.

Affiant respectfully requests that a warrant be issued for the arrest of the said Alvin C. Robertson charging him with the offense of Sex Trafficking of Minor, Sexual Performance of a Child, and Sexual Assault of a Child. In Violation of Section 20A.02, 43.25, and 22.011 of the Texas Penal Code.
