Pursuant to Rule 7.1 of the Arkansas Rules of Criminal Procedure, the undersigned affiant(s) being duly sworn, deposes and says that he has reason to believe that the above named person has committed the offense of violating AR. Code Ann. 5-11-102 KIDNAPPING on or about the date of May 16th, 2010, which states: A person commits the offense of KIDNAPPING (a) if, without consent he restrains another person so as to interfere substantially with his liberty with the purpose of; (4) Inflicting physical injury upon him, or of engaging in sexual intercourse, deviate sexual activity, or sexual contact with him (5) terrorizing him or another person.

FACTS CONSTITUTING REASONABLE CAUSE

I, Detective Robert A Martin of the Little Rock Police Department, state that the following is true to the best of my knowledge:

On May, 16, 2010, at approximately 1920 hours, a white male knocked on the front door of the residence located at 412 Shamrock, in Little Rock, Arkansas. The resident, Haliagh Millwee (w/f; 02/17/86) opened the front door and talked to the male through the storm door. The male had in his possession, a white dog and he was asking Ms. Millwee if she knew who owned the dog. When Ms. Millwee opened the screen door to look at the dog's tags, the white male suspect forced his way into Ms. Millwee's residence and shoved her to the ground. The white male suspect then put on Laytex gloves, handcuffed her hands behind her back, and used zip ties to bind her legs together at the ankles. The suspect then stuffed an object into her mouth and blindfolded her with a red bandana. The suspect then left Ms. Millwee in the front room and she could hear him rummaging

through the drawers in her bedroom. After going through Ms. Millwee's bedroom, the suspect then returned to the front room and removed her handcuffs, cut the zip ties from her legs, and removed her blindfold and gag. The suspect then forcibly dragged Ms. Millwee out of her front door while he was carrying a bag that belonged to Ms. Millwee that he had taken from her bedroom.

While the suspect was dragging Ms. Millwee out of her residence, he was hitting her and he slammed her head into the concrete and tried to cut her on the back with his box cutter. Once the suspect got Ms. Millwee in the front yard, he was attempting to drag her towards his vehicle that Ms. Millwee described as a green Ford Explorer. The suspect had parked his vehicle in Millwee's driveway. Ms. Millwee started screaming and a neighbor, Greg Alagood, heard her and came to her assistance. The suspect was trying to remove suspicion from himself by saying something about taking Ms. Millwee to "rehab". When Mr. Alagood came to Ms. Millwee's aide, the suspect fled from the area in the green Ford Explorer.

Little Rock Police, Detectives and Crime Scene personnel responded to the scene. Ms. Millwee advised responding officers that she lost consciousness twice during the incident. Ms. Millwee had several visible injuries to her face, lower back, back of her head, upper back, and her legs. She was taken to Baptist Hospital by a relative for treatment.

On 05-18-10 I received a call from Patrick Millwee (father of the Haliagh Millwee) Mr. Millwee advised that he had received a phone call from a family friend who advised him that last year a white male by the name of Jim Huff attacked a friend of his (Allison Rose) at 10 Leslie Circle. The caller advised Mr. Millwee that Mr. Huff was wearing blue latex gloves and forced his way in on the female and he thought this was similar to the attack on Haliagh Millwee.

An incident report was located in reference to the incident at #10 Leslie Circle (Inc # 2009-62915) which was filed on 06-04 -09 by a Mrs. Allison Rose. This report showed Mr. Jim Hoff of 14 Leslie Circle, Little Rock, AR, as a suspect and the report stated that on 06-04 -09 at approximately 2250 hrs Mr. Hoff knocked on the front door of #10 Leslie Circle and advised Mrs. Rose that something was on fire in her front yard. Mrs. Rose stated that Mr. Hoff has a gun and attempted to force his way into the residence and during the struggle broke the storm door handle. Mrs. Rose advised that Mr. Hoff was wearing blue gloves and was armed with a gun which she was able to take away from him. Mr. Hoff also swung at Mr. Rose but missed at which time he advised Mr. Rose he was going to get him. Officer arrived and took Mr. Hoff home to 14 Leslie Circle and turned him over to the custody of his wife.

A second incident report was located under the name of Jim Huff in reference to a vehicle accident (Inc#2009-95596) Showing Jim Huff WM DOB: 10-09-53 of 14 Leslie Circle as the owner/driver of a 1995 Ford Explore, green in color, bearing Arkansas license 559LNJ that was involved in an accident at University and Evergreen on 08-20-09.

On 05-19-10 Det. Eason made contact with Mr. Greg Alagood and showed him a photo spread bearing Inc# 10-51480 labeled A containing six (6) similar looking white males. Mr. Alagood picked the subject in the number five (5) position as a look alike stating that out of all the people on the photo spread this subject was the one that look the most like the subject. The person in the number five (5) position was Jim Huff.

Page 3 of 4 Page Document

On 05-19-10 Det. Martin made contact with Haliagh Millwee and showed her a photo spread bearing Inc#10-51480 labeled B containing six similar looking white males. Ms. Milwee immediately and positively identified the subject t in the number two (2) position as the subject that attacked her on 05-16-10. The person in the number two (2) position was Jim Huff.

I swear that the allegations contained herein are the truth, the whole truth and nothing but the truth.
