Dear Sir,

On this date Brandon DeAngelo Craig came to the Little Rock Police Department to talk with detectives about his missing girlfriend, Sherita Allen. Mr. Craig initially gave conflicting accounts. Mr. Craig's Miranda rights were rendered and he conveyed the following circumstances. Mr. Craig advised he got his brother-in-law, Quincy Smith to drop him off at the McDonald's at Kanis and Rodney Parham to meet Sherita at approximately 12noon on Friday, May 21, 2010. Mr. Craig says he made a purchase at McDonald's, they went to an unknown location to pay a bill in North Little Rock and drove around. Mr. Craig says as they were driving around, Sherita reached in the glove box for lip balm and he inquired about why she would have a gun. He said he pulled the silver gun out of the glove box and started playing with it at which time Ms. Allen was struck accidently. Ms. Allen was driving and the drivers window shattered as the car rested upon the curb. Craig said when Sherita was shot, she rested upon his shoulder. He got out of the car and moved Sherita to the passenger side and he took control of the vehicle.

Craig says he drove a short distance on the same street and located a green trash dumpster that was left on the side of the curb. He laid the green trash dumpster down and put Sherita inside, set the dumpster upright and left. Craig said Allen was not moving and he never called 911 or anyone for help. He said he tried cleaning up the inside of the car at the Car Wash across from Taco Bell on Barrow with a foam brush. He says he parked her car by War Memorial Swimming Pool and left.

According to Craig he had been dating Sheretta for about six to eight months. Mr. Brandon DeAngelo Craig is charged with Murder First in the death of his Sherita Allen. Mr. Craig admitted during interview he shot at killed Allen.
