SUBJECT: Arrest of Jaquon Beasley (10-75092)

Sir,

On today's date at approx. 2215 hours I responded to #5 Office Park in reference to a car that was found burning at that address. Little Rock Fire Department was called to a vehicle fire at approx. 2133 hours and once they extinguished the fire they found what appeared to be the remains of a human body sitting in the driver's seat of a 2010 Toyota Corolla bearing AR LPN 904OMI. The Fire Department immediately called for Police after they discovered the body. The vehicle shows to return to an address of 13021 Pleasant Forest Dr. Detectives responded to that location in an attempt to identify the owner. Det. Hudson and Det. Simpson made contact with Gaylord Sheppard (B/M, 04-24-1965) at that address and he advised that the car belongs to his daughter, Jasmine Sheppard (B/F, 09-21-1989), and that she had not returned home from work. Mr. Sheppard stated that his daughter works at Home Depot and that she was supposed to get off work at 2100 hours. Mr. Sheppard told Detectives that she had been having problems with her ex-boyfriend, Jaquon Beasley, and that the two of them had broken up approx. three (3) weeks ago.


Detectives located an address for Mr. Beasley, at #8 Nandina Circle Apt. #3, and went to the address to make contact with him. When we arrived at the address we made contact with Sanami Greer who advised that Mr. Beasley was her son and that he was at his grandfather's house located at 9719 Relda.

Detectives responded to 9719 Relda at approx. 0345 hours and made contact with Mr. Beasley. Mr. Beasley came out of the residence and agreed to talk with Det. Simpson and I. While we spoke with Mr. Beasley, Det. Hudson made contact with Mr. Beasley's grandfather and uncle. They told Det. Hudson that Mr. Beasley came home and told them that he had killed Ms. Sheppard. Det. Hudson then relayed this information to Det. Simpson and I and we immediately placed Mr. Beasley under arrest.

Mr. Beasley was transported to the Downtown Detectives Division where he agreed to waive his rights and make a statement. Mr. Beasley gave a taped and videoed statement confessing to stabbing Ms. Sheppard and then setting her and her vehicle on fire. Based on Mr. Beasley's statement Detectives believe that Ms. Sheppard was still alive when she and the vehicle were set on fire. Mr. Beasley was charged with Capital Murder and transported to Southside Intake for processing.
