Dear Deputy Marks:

On September 13, 2010, Little Rock arrested Richard Duncan and transported him to this facility for video arraignment. You allegedly failed to search inmate Duncan when Sergeant Parker brought him into D-Unit. Due to him not being searched, he was able to conceal a handgun and bring it into the unit.

**Violation (s) and Meeting:**

This allegation indicates that you may be in violation of the **Pulaski County Sheriff's Office Uniform Standards of Conduct**, in particular;

**Standard 01...Affirmatively Promoting a Positive Public Image**

**Standard 06...Committing Unsafe Acts or Endangering Self or Others**

**Standard 12...Displaying Competent Performances and Achieving Competent Performance Results**


**Standard 17...Knowing, Observing and Obeying All Directives, Rules, Policies, Procedures, Practices and Traditions**

As a result of this finding, you are hereby suspended without pay for five (5) working days. These days of suspension will be October 14, 17, 18, 19 and 20, 2010. During this suspension period, you are directed not to perform any law enforcement functions other than attending any court appearance to which you have been subpoenaed.
