Pursuant to Rule 7.1 of the Arkansas Rules of Criminal Procedure, the undersigned affiant(s) being duly sworn, deposes and says that he has reason to believe that the above-named person has committed the offense of violating Ark. Code Ann. 5-10-101 Capital Murder on or

about the 2nd day of January 2011, committed by unlawfully

(a) A person commits capital murder if: (1) Acting alone or with one (1) or more other persons:

(A) The person Commits or attempts to commit:

(vi) Aggravated robbery 5-12-103; (B) in the course of and in furtherance of the felony or in immediate flight from the felony, the person or an accomplice causes the death of a person under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to the value of human life.

in Pulaski County, Arkansas, against the peace and dignity of the State of Arkansas.

FACTS CONSTITUTING REASONABLE CAUSE

I, Investigator Garrett, Do Solemnly swear that I am a Criminal Investigator with the Pulaski County Sheriff's Office and the following is true and factual to the best of my knowledge. On January 2, 2011, at 1332 Hrs, Pulaski County Sheriff's Deputies responded to an aggravated robbery at 318 East 43rd Street, (McAlmont Community) North Little Rock, AR. When Deputies arrived on scene it was discovered that one of the residents Evon Henderson had been shot and killed by one of the suspects. Pulaski County Sheriff's Office Investigations was notified and responded to the scene, at which time contact was made with two victims, Edward Henderson and Byron Lawrence, the apparent intended targets of the robbery. Both subjects were interview by an investigator and provided the following information :

Edward Henderson >> in a recorded statement Mr. Henderson stated he was in his room positioned at the very rear of the residence, and his Nephew Byron Lawrence was outside talking to the suspects. Mr. Henderson stated his nephew entered the residence through the back door that accesses Mr. Henderson's room. Mr. Henderson stated the two suspects entered the room also, at which time both suspects brandished guns and demanded money from he and Mr. Lawrence. Mr. Henderson stated that at some point during the robbery, his sister Evon Henderson who was watching television in the front room, came to the rear of the house and closed the door to Mr. Henderson's bedroom. Mr. Henderson stated one of the suspects turned and fired his gun at the door and then fled the residence and got

Into an older model green Pontiac Bonneville and fled the area. Mr. Henderson stated Mr. Lawrence fled out the back door, and he went into the kitchen, where he found Mrs. Henderson laying on the floor suffering from a gunshot wound in the back.

Byron Lawrence >>> Mr. Lawrence in a recorded statement stated his cousin Tevin Bradley and an unknown black male later identified by citizens in the neighborhood as Veeders Latirus Nelson, came to his residence. Mr. Lawrence stated he was outside having small talk with the suspects at which point they went into the back door into Mr. Henderson room to smoke a "Joint." Mr. Lawrence stated once they entered the room Veeders Nelson pulled a black revolver and demanded money from him and Mr. Henderson. Mr. Lawrence stated at some point his Aunt Mrs. Henderson came through the kitchen and closed the door to Mr. Henderson's room. Mr. Lawrence stated Mr. Nelson immediately fired one time through the door, and he and the suspects all ran out the back door. Mr. Lawrence stated he ran east on Wallace Street into the woods, and the suspects fled in an older model green Pontiac Bonneville. Mr. Lawrence stated he did not return until the Sheriff's Office had already arrived.

The victim Evon Henderson was shot through the door, and the bullet struck her in the right side of her torso, with an entrance/exit wound observed on the right side of her back and right front just below her right breast. Mrs. Henderson traveled approximately 16 feet before collapsing on the kitchen floor where she died. MEMS responded to the scene and found the victim deceased on the kitchen floor.
