- A. Contact all utilities 48 Hours prior to construction or and/excavation work.
- B. Submit construction plan for review approval by Public Works Civil Engineering Division at (501) 371-4811
- C. Ensure Traffic Control Devices comply with 2003 version of Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD). Traffic Control Devices shall be installed as required by the MUTCD.
- D. Use flagmen and Traffic Control Devices AS SHOWN on Traffic Engineering's approved barricade plan.
- E. Do not obstruct view of traffic signals, signs or other Traffic Control Devices.
- F. Protect open, non-street, excavations with Traffic Control Devices as Traffic Engineering requires.
- G. Comply with any additional requirements listed on Traffic Control Permit. See requirements below.

Possession of this permit does not, in any way, relieve the requirements of Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD, Latest Edition) for Traffic Control Procedures. Failure to comply with MUTCD requirements will void the permit.
