
**PETITION FOR ORDER OF REMOVAL**

COMES NOW the State of Arkansas and based upon good faith knowledge and belief hereby states:

1. The Defendant is the Mayor of Caddo Valley, Arkansas.
2. That the Defendant was convicted of the offense of Theft in the State of Texas as provided by Judgment dated August 1, 1969.
3. That the conviction is of an infamous crime. See generally, *State v. Oldner*, 361 Ark. 316; 206 S.W.3d 818 (2005).
