ON THIS 30th DAY OF MAY, 2012, THE COURT, *sua sponte*, AND ISSUES THE FOLLOWING ORDER:


1. The Court has issued numerous fugitive warrants on various defendants in the Circuit Court of Phillips County, Arkansas.
2. It has come to the attention of the Court that the Sheriff of Phillips County, Arkansas, has made little, if any, attempts to serve the warrants on the various defendants nor has his office placed the fugitive status on ACIC.
3. This, among other things, has helped to create a serious backlog of cases in Phillips County. The Court intends to address this backlog during the Summer term, which begins July 30, 2012.
4. In order to for the Court to address these cases, the office of the Phillips County Sheriff's Department shall take the following steps:
 - a. make a priority of serving all fugitive warrants
 - b. Notify the defendants served of the Court's pre-trial and term dates and order their appearance
 - c. Enter the fugitive status information in ACIC immediately.


