

ORDER

A hearing was held in the matter of defendant Richard Conte' s Motion for Release on Own Recognizance under Ark. Rules Crim. Pro. Rule 28.1, on Friday, October 26, 2012. The motion is granted and the defendant is released under the following conditions: 1) The defendant is released to Mr. Frank Bruns, who resides at 8429 W. 66th Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin; 2) The defendant will travel with Mr. Bruns to the residence of Marian Conte-Romberger, 5517 N. Kent Avenue, Whitefish Bay, Wisconsin, however the defendant must have a GPS device attached to his person prior to leaving the jail. The defendant must wear the GPS device continuously until further order from the Court. The defendant will depart with Mr. Brun on Saturday evening or Sunday morning and will arrive at Ms. Conte-Romberger' s residence no later than the afternoon of Monday, October 29, 2012; 3) the defendant will confirm his arrival at 5517 N. Kent Avenue to the Faulkner County Sheriff' s Department; 4) the defendant will remain at 5517 N. Kent Avenue under house-arrest, with GPS monitoring; 5) the defendant will abide by a no contact order executed on October 26, 2012; and

6) the defendant will remain in contact with his attorney, Jack T. Lassiter.
