16 extended for two (2) additional contract terms upon appropriation, satisfactory performance and mutual
17 agreement of the parties.

18 **Section 5. Severability.** In the event any portion of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be
19 invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of this
20 resolution, which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or
21 unconstitutional were not originally a part of this resolution.
