23	Section 2. Funds for these programs are from the 2013 PIT Allocation, account number S15A125.		
24	Section 4. The term of the contract is from March 1, 2013, to February 28, 2014, and may be		
25	extended for two (2) additional contract terms upon appropriation, satisfactory performance and mutual		
26	agreement of the parties.		
27	Section 5. Severability. In the event any portion of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be		
28	invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of this		
29	resolution, which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or		
30	unconstitutional were not originally a part of this resolution.		
31	Section 6. Repealer. All ordinances and resolutions, and parts thereof, which are in conflict with any		
32	provision of this resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
