Dear Attorney General Rutledge:

We are writing to request an Attorney General's opinion based on the following:

BACKGROUND

This matter is in regards to Act 746 of 2013. Under Act 746 of 2013, Arkansans are allowed to carry a handgun without a concealed carry license or other weapon if the person is on a journey. See Ark. Code Ann. §5-73-119(e)(7), §5-73-120(b)(3), and §5-73-120 (c)(4). After Act 746, "journey" is defined as "[travel] beyond the county in which the person lives."

QUESTIONS

- Is it your opinion that Act 746 of 2013 permits a person to carry a handgun or other weapon, in plain view or concealed, without a concealed handgun license if he or she leaves his or her county so long as he or she is not otherwise prohibited by state or federal law?
- 2. Further, does Act 746 of 2013 permit a person not on a journey to openly or concealed carry a handgun or other weapon in public without violating the criminal offense of carrying a weapon, §5-73-120, so long as he or she has no "purpose to attempt to unlawfully employ the ... weapon against a person"? See Ark. Code Ann. §5-73-120(a).
- 3. Specifically, please verify that if a person who carries a handgun or other weapon in public, open or concealed, who is simply minding his or her own business, would not be violating the criminal offense of carrying a weapon if he or she has not demonstrated a "purpose to attempt to unlawfully employ" the handgun or other weapon against another person.
