

AGREED ORDER


Comes now the State of Arkansas and the Defendant, represented by counsel, with this agreed order and that both parties state:

1. That Defendant, Jack W. Gillean, having been found guilty by a jury and sentenced to 3 years in the Arkansas Department of Corrections, and this verdict having been affirmed by the Arkansas Court of Appeals does hereby waive all further appeals afforded him by the U. S. Constitution, Arkansas Constitution, Arkansas case law, and Arkansas Code Annotated concerning the above-styled matter.
2. The State of Arkansas, represented by Prosecuting Attorney Cody Hiland, in exchange for Defendant's waiver of appeals, does agree to dismiss the petition to revoke Defendant's probation filed on December 14, 2015. The State is not waiving the right to file future petitions to revoke should new ground(s) arise.
3. The Defendant will remain in custody at the Faulkner County Detention Center until he is transferred to ADC, where he will immediately begin serving his sentence, and will forfeit the appeal bond Defendant had previously been granted.


