STATE'S RESPONSE TO DEFENDANT'S MOTION FOR
EMERGENCY HEARING

Comes now the State of Arkansas, by and through Hugh Finkelstein, Deputy Prosecuting Attorney, and for its Response to Defendant's Motion, states as follows:

1. That the defendant is charged with two counts of Capital Murder as well as other charges and is being held without bond.
2. That on April 10, 2016, the Faulkner County Sheriff's Department conducted a random search of the defendant's pod, which contained various cells belonging to the defendant as well as other incarcerated persons. Searches such as these are regularly conducted in the jail in order to search for contraband.
3. During a search of the defendant's cell, contraband was found and seized by the Sheriff's Office. None of the defendant's legal mail was seized during the search.
4. After the search was completed, the defendant became disorderly and was warned more than once to stop banging on the door to the pod. After he refused to stop, pursuant to jail policy, the defendant was placed in a restraining chair.
5. None of this was a violation of the defendant's Constitutional rights.

WHEREFORE, the State respectfully prays that this Court deny this motion.


