Brief Description of Ecclesia College:

Ecclesia College was founded in 1975 in Springdale, Arkansas. The college is nationally accredited through ABHE and state certified by ADHE. Ecclesia College is a four-year, private, liberal arts college built on the innovative and highly effective work college model where every student's education is rooted in the development of good character and the formation of a strong work ethic. EC graduates enter the workforce with less than \$6000 in total debt, and their consistently strong work ethic makes them more dependable and sought after by employers.

Need and Nature of the Project:

To purchase a 25.5-acre parcel of land with an existing student residence hall and shop facility adjacent to the existing Ecclesia College property necessary to provide critically needed space for incoming resident students beginning fall of 2014 as well as development of additional work learning assignments. This property expansion is critical to providing increased educational opportunities to students enrolling in Arkansas' only federally recognized Work College.

Improvements to the Local Area:

The completion of this project will create opportunities for many more Arkansas students to participate in a work college environment while earning a valuable education and being engaged in local community service projects throughout Arkansas. The economic development of Arkansas is intrinsically linked with higher education graduation rates. To whom it may concern:

This letter is intended to provide further explanation for the Ecclesia College application for GIF.

Ecclesia College is one of only seven federally recognized work-learning colleges in the United States. The closest one that you might be most familiar with is College of the Ozarks near Branson, MO.

One of the primary obstacles for students being able to attend Ecclesia College is our lack of residence hall and classroom space. We literally have run out of places to house and educate additional students in our current facilities. We have experienced rapid growth in the size of our student body over the past ten years since receiving accreditation and we are now facing a potential crisis beginning in fall of 2015 with an anticipated record enrollment that will require additional housing and classroom facilities.

Over the past year we have developed a strategic solution to facilitate our projected growth. Our plan included the acquisition of four large homes nearby our campus. Each home would be renovated and converted into residence halls necessary to increasing our ability to house additional full-time students.

The first of the four housing renovations is nearing completion as we look toward the upcoming fall semester. Several Arkansas House and Senate members helped us with this project through GIF requests. The property included a large house and 23.25 acres adjacent to the main Ecclesia College campus. The cost of this property totaled \$565,000

The second property we are currently requesting funding for is a 25.5 acre piece of property with a large home, a 2400 sq. ft. shop, a barn and other storage buildings. The total cost of this project is \$500,000. This acquisition includes a large home, which will provide much needed additional residence space to the college, while the peripheral buildings can be utilized for dairy and agriculture industries of our work program in which each enrolled student participates fifteen hours per week.

We are grateful for all the financial support on the first house that will be used for student housing this fall. The need for additional student housing is almost unending. The demand for attending work colleges is high with not nearly enough available student housing to accept all the applicants we are expecting for the fall 2015 semester beginning in August.

Furthermore, the Grantee agrees to hold harmless the Grantor from any and all claims, suits and actions arising from any act of omission, noncompliance or misuse of grant funds by the Grantee or any employee or agent in the performance of this Grant Agreement.

7. METHOD OF PAYMENT

The Grantor shall make payment of authorized grant funds upon proper execution of this Grant Agreement by the Grantee. The Grantor reserves the right to determine the most appropriate distribution of payments, based upon the nature of the approved project. In no event will the total amount of grant funds to the Grantee for allowable expenses incurred in relation to the project exceed the amount noted on Page 1 of this Agreement as the Grant Amount.

8. MODIFICATIONS

The Grant Agreement may be modified, at the discretion of the Grantor, only with prior written notification from the Grantee. The Grantee will be notified, in writing, of the decision of the Grantor.
