

ORDINANCE NO. 83-69

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 46 AND AMENDING ORDINANCE 79-44 TO LIMIT THE POSSESSION AND SALE OF FIREWORKS IN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF BENTONVILLE, ARKANSAS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BENTONVILLE, ARKANSAS:

Section 1: That Ordinance 46 be and is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2: That section 17.03 of the standard fire prevention code enacted as Ordinance 79-44 of the City of Bentonville be amended to except those businesses engaged in the wholesale or retail sale of fireworks as specifically located within those areas annexed to the City of Bentonville after July 4, 1983. Said use shall be restricted to the manner and location wherein said sale was occurring on that date.

Section 3: That this Ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage as required by law.
