WHEREAS, some county employees have refused to sign the consent forms required for the criminal background check which jeopardizes the county's fidelity bond coverage and is direct violation of Ordinance No. 1457.

NOW THEREFORE, IT'S RESOLVED BY THE UNION COUNTY QUORUM COURT THAT the County Clerk and County Judge are hereby authorized and directed to withhold payments from previously appropriated funds covering salaries of employees who refuse to consent to the criminal background check as directed by Ordinance No. 1457. Wages owed through the close of business on October 19, 2017 shall be paid.
