Eco-Vista Landfill – Certificate of Need Petitions Wednesday, April 18, 2018



609 Acre Property:

- •MSW Landfill 66 acre closed landfill; 79.8 acre active landfill
 - 3,645,000 CY airspace remaining
 - 1,700 Tons Per Day Remaining life = 5.5 years
 - Construction & Demolition Waste Landfill 28.5 acres
 - 955,000 CY airspace remaining
 - 200 Tons Per Day Remaining life = 9.5 years
- •These are the only MSW & C&D Landfills in the District and NW Arkansas
- •No out-of-state waste comes to the Eco-Vista Landfill









Eco-Vista Landfill – Proposed 3-Phase Expansion:

- Class 1/MSW Landfill Phase 1 10 Acre Footprint
- Class 1/MSW Landfill Phase 2 50 Acre Footprint
- Class 4/Construction & Demolition Waste Landfill 12
 Acre Footprint












CLASS 1 PHASE 1 EXPANSION AREA WEST - EAST SECTION







Northwest Arkansas Demographics Why Eco-Vista's Expansion is Needed



- Northwest Arkansas Demographics (from: Northwest Arkansas Council)
 - 14th in the nation in its Growth Rate
 - Adding 34 people per day
 - 12,287 additional residents between July 2016 and July 2017
 - 2017 Beaver Water District broke an all-time record selling 18.6 billion gallons of water 6% increase over 2016
- Population Growth requires growth of the area infrastructure
 - Water & Sewer Systems need to grow or expand
 - Schools need to grow or expand
 - Roads need to grow or expand
 - All infrastructure (include waste management facilities) need to grow or expand



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2013 Tonnage 428,177 Tons (1,530 TPD)
2014 Tonnage 474,592 Tons (1,695 TPD)
2015 Tonnage 501,342 Tons (1,790 TPD)
2016 Tonnage 516,643 Tons (1,845 TPD)
2017 Tonnage 526,077 Tons (1,880 TPD)
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- 2013 to 2017 = 22.8% Increase
- 97,900 ton per year increase

- 500' Voluntary Set-Back from Arbor Acres Road
- ADEQ Permitting Regulations
 - Regulation 22 Solid Waste Management Rules
 - 4:1 Side Slopes
 - Minimum Setback Requirements for Active Portions of Landfill:
 - 100' Property Boundary
 - 300' Existing Dwellings
 - 500' Drinking Water Wells



- Proposed Phase 1 Class 1/MSW Landfill
 - 10 acre footprint
 - Approximately 7,100,000 CY Airspace
 - 12 years of life
 - 2023 to 2035



- Proposed Phase 2 Class 1/MSW Landfill
 - 50 acre footprint
 - Approximately 8,500,000 CY Airspace
 - 14 years of life
 - 2035 to 2049



- Proposed Construction & Demolition Waste Landfill Expansion
 - 12 acre footprint
 - Approximately 1,200,000 CY Airspace
 - 7 years of life
 - 2026 to 2033
