





#### 2018 Police Activity Overview

- 4,746 Custodial Arrests (Felony and Misdemeanor)












# WHY WE DO NOT POLICE BASED ON POPULATION DEMOGRAPHICS


- Assumes only Fayetteville residents are subject of law enforcement actions (Citations and Arrests)
- Would require a "Quota" based on demographics
- Assumes population offends at the same rate (e.g. Males vs. Females)
- Assumes Census numbers are accurate and not outdated
  - Fayetteville School District Student Demographics
    - 68 % Caucasian
    - 32 % Minority

#### **Adult Custodial Arrests**

- •In 2003, of the 10,059 Adult Custodial arrests, 50 were for Misd Marijuana Only. 6 juveniles were also arrested for Misd Marijuana Only.
- •In 2008, of the 4,590 adult custodial arrests, 24 were for Misd Marijuana Only. 11 juveniles were also arrested for Misd Marijuana Only.
- •In 2018, of the 4,746 adult custodial arrests, 20 were for Misd Marijuana Only. 18 juveniles were also arrested for Misd Marijuana Only.

#### Citation vs Arrest

- •In 2014, Judge David Stewart authorized FPD officers to issue citations for Class A Misdemeanors.
- •Benefits of citation versus arrest.
- •Common offenses for criminal tickets are shoplifting, misdemeanor marijuana, possession of drug paraphernalia, possession of fraudulent identification, and warrants.
- •In 2018, FPD issued 1,103 criminal citations in lieu of arrest.
- 154 Misdemeanor Marijuana Only

#### Misdemeanor Marijuana Arrest Rate

In 2008, 35 Marijuana arrests and a population of 73,999 35/73,999 = .00047\*100,000 = 47 per 100,000 population

In 2018, 38 Marijuana arrests and a population of 84,726 38/84,726 = .00045\*100,000 = 45 per 100,000 population

# 2018 MARIJUANA ARRESTS AS A PERCENTAGE OF TOTAL ACTIVITY

- Marijuana PCS Only Adult Custodial Arrests: 20
- FPD Total Adult Custodial Arrests: 4746
- In 2018, custodial marijuana PCS only arrests accounted for <u>LESS THAN HALF OF ONE PERCENT</u> (0.42%) of all FPD Adult Custodial arrests.

#### 4<sup>th</sup> JUDICIAL DISTRICT DRUG TASK FORCE


- Multi-Jurisdictional Task Force (10 participating agencies)
- 4th Judicial District covers Washington and Madison Counties
- Started in 1991, the 4<sup>th</sup> JDDTF is overseen by a control board, and supervised by a Fayetteville Police Department Sergeant
- The City of Fayetteville has been the fiduciary since it's inception
- High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA)
- Mission is to identify, investigate, and arrest persons and organizations involved in possessing, manufacturing and trafficking of narcotics.


#### 4<sup>th</sup> JDDTF Funding


July 1, 2018 thru June 30, 2019

- •DTF Funding comes from Federal and State Grants and HIDTA Funds
- DTF Total Budget for all 10 agencies is \$804,303.
- •Fayetteville's portion of the total DTF budget is \$531,149

The City of Fayetteville receives \$308,691 The City of Fayetteville contributes \$222,458








# 4th JDDTF Arrest Demographics (2017-May 2019)


- Gun/Drug Seizures:

  - 472 dosage units of LSD
  - 683 Ecstasy pills
  - 23 Drug Trafficking Organizations Disrupted or Dismantled
  - 8 Meth labs
