To the Parents, Students, Staff, and Community Stakeholders of the Pine Bluff School District:

As you may know, on July 29, 2021, the Governor of Arkansas declared a state of emergency due to an increase in COVID-19 cases. In an effort to protect our students and staff, we are implementing a mask mandate in our district, effective immediately. A mask or face covering must be worn over the nose and mouth at all times on district property and on busses, except for eating and drinking, by all students, staff, and visitors. Visitors will be welcome, however, should be prepared to adhere to procedures and protocols we have in place to include limiting the number of people in small enclosed offices and spaces, social distancing, and of course adhering to requirements to wear face coverings.
