

## Redistricting Timeline

**September 22, 2021:** Redistricting Committee Chair Carol Berz requests help from city staff with tabulation of census data within existing city council borders, to help prepare a framework for the committee's works.

**October 6th, 2021:** Initial redistricting committee meeting, OPMOD highlighted census data used for redistricting, redistricting requirements/considerations and methodology for developing the new districts.

**October 7th, 2021:** Met with GIS technician from State Comptroller's office to go over their redistricting tool.

**October 8th - December 8th, 2021:** Used Comptroller's redistricting tool and methodology to develop council districts that would be in compliance with federal, state and local law.

**December 9th, 2021:** Redistricting committee meets, is shown potential districts using new census data that would comply with federal, state and local law, and is walked through the methodology used for tabulation. Also heard from the City Attorney about the definition of 'minority' to use when reviewing demographic totals for each council district and any considerations from the 1989 Brown v. Board of Commissioners Supreme Court case.

**December 9th 2021 - February 15th 2022:** Met individually with council members between Dec 9th and Feb 15th to provide more specific information pertaining to each individual council district using new methodology.

**February 15th, 2022:** Redistricting committee meeting to present the updated map based on individual council members' feedback, map placed on council agenda for consideration and deliberation.

**March 1st, 2022:** Presented redistricting map to the full city council during the council meeting and posted conforming map and methodology on Chattadata, the city's open data portal.

**March 2nd - March 29th, 2022:** Individual feedback gathered from members of city council, and council district meetings held in individual districts.
