6	(3) Prohibit an action necessary to establish or maintain			
7	eligibility for a federal program if ineligibility would demonstrably result

9	(4) Preempt state discrimination law or federal discrimination

11	(e) A person who negligently violates this section is guilty of a			
12	Class A misdemeanor.
