Very basic descriptions:

Response fee – 911 is called, ambulance responds, treats patient on scene but does not transport

BLS - basic life support - transport with no medical procedures

ALS 1 – advanced life support – patients receive ALS assessment, normally an IV and sometimes EKG or oxygen

ALS 2 – advanced life support – patients receive same as ALS 1 plus additional medications and lifesaving medical procedures
