INCIDENT REPORT

NARRATIVE

While stationary at 3rd Ave West I clocked a silver Nissan Altima with radar at 63 mph in a 35 mph zone traveling North. As I pulled into roadway to initiate a traffic stop the vehicle was stopped partially in the turn lane behind a green Ford Ranger driven by Eddie Kendrick who was stopped at the red light. After checking both vehicles for damage I had them pull into the Eton Plaza shopping center to continue the accident investigation. As the Altima was making the turn onto Hwy 286 it almost struck a vehicle in the side that was traveling south on Hwy 411. After pulling into the parking lot of Eton Plaza the driver of the Altima (Jennifer Zeigler) exited the vehicle and I immediately noticed she was unsteady on her feet as she stumbled while walking to the front of the vehicle to check for damage. I asked for her drivers license and informed her she almost struck another vehicle while making her turn and she stated that she had to get to Bagley (Middle School). I noticed that her eyes were blood shot and that her speech was slurred and asked if she had been drinking, she stated no and again said she had to get to Bagley. I checked both vehicles again for damage finding only very slight damage to the Altima's front bumper. Ms Zeigler stated she did not care about the damage to her car and again stated she had to be Bagley by 6:30 to open the school.

Ms Zeigker continued to appear unsteady on her feet and having slurred speech so I requested she perform field sobriety test. I attempted to perform the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus test but after four attempts she failed to follow my instructions and was swaying back and forth. I then had her perform the walk and turn test and again she would not follow my instructions. When told to stand with her right foot in front of her left foot heel to toe she stated she could not do it because she was left handed. She continued swaying back and forth while I demonstrated the test. She continued to say she was left handed and requested to be taken to the hospital for a blood test. I explained that the field sobriety test were for me to determine if further test were needed and requested she perform the one leg stand. After demonstrating the test she put her foot down on the three count loosing her balance, she attempted again and put her foot down after the one count loosing her balance and stepping backwards. Ms Zeigler agreed to give a breath sample in an alco-sensor, after giving her instructions how to blow into the tube she begin sucking through the tube instead of blowing. I instructed her to blow and she attempted to restrict the air flow by tightening her lips and barely blowing, the results showed positive for alcohol.

I placed her in the back of my patrol car and read the implied consent notice requesting blood and urine, she agreed and was transported to Murray Medical Center. Lab Tech Zane Thompson administered the blood test then Ms Zeigler was giving a cup and instructed to give a urine sample. She filled the cup with water from the toilet and stated she thought she was to get the urine from the toilet, she was given another cup and instructed again to give a urine sample. This time she filled the cup with water from the sink and stated she thought she needed to finish filling the urine with water to fill the cup. I then informed her I was charging her with DUI refusal and she requested the hospital staff collect the urine sample by a catheder. Murray Medical nurse Nancy Machoka collected the sample by urine catheder and the samples were sealed by Zane Thompson and given to arresting officer. She was transported to the MCSO and turned over to the jail staff for booking on the above charges.
