Scope

Our review included an examination of funds administered by the district attorneys general for the year ended June 30, 2011. In addition, our review included an examination of judicial districts' drug task force funds administered by the task forces' boards of directors for the year ended June 30, 2011.

Results

Five judicial districts had findings. We reviewed these findings and recommendations with the district attorneys general and representatives of the drug task forces. Details of these findings, recommendations, and management's responses, as a result of our review, are presented in the Findings, Recommendations, and Financial Section of this report.

The following are summaries of the findings from our review:

THIRD JUDICIAL DISTRICT

- The Drug Task Force had accounting and financial deficiencies.
- Deficiencies were noted in the recording and management of seized property.
- ♦ Adequate documentation was not maintained to support some confidential expenditures.
- Deficiencies were noted in the receipting and depositing of funds.
- Purchases were not made in accordance with the county's purchasing procedures.
- Equipment inventory control records were not properly maintained.
- Required reports were not submitted in a timely manner.

EIGHTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT

◆ The Drug Task Force had unallowable costs of \$15,227 related to the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act Justice Assistance Grant.

TENTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT

- A forfeiture warrant was not filed in court.
- An assistant district attorney used a Drug Task Force fuel card to fuel his personal vehicle used for official business instead of personally purchasing the fuel and filing itemized expense claims for reimbursement.

EIGHTEENTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT

• The Drug Task Force had deficiencies in the use of federal funds.

TWENTY-FOURTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT

♦ The Drug Task Force had a cash shortage of \$5,565 at June 30, 2011.

INTRODUCTION

This report reviews funds administered by District Attorneys General and Judicial District Drug Task Forces for the year ended June 30, 2011, for the first through the thirty-first judicial districts of the State of Tennessee. A separate review was conducted in each of the 31 judicial districts of the funds administered by the District Attorneys General and Judicial District Drug Task Forces. The results of our reviews of the judicial districts are presented in this report.

BACKGROUND

Each judicial district comprises from one to seven counties. Main offices are generally in the county where the district attorney general resides, with branch offices located in other counties. The district attorneys general had funds on deposit with some county trustees included in the respective judicial districts. The county trustees had one or more of the following types of funds on deposit: District Attorney General, Drug Task Force, Federal Asset Forfeiture, Metro/County Appropriations, Mediation Services, and Others.

District Attorney General Fund

The District Attorney General Fund is used primarily to account for fees received from violating the Fraud and Economic Crimes Prosecution Act of 1984. In addition, this fund accounts for other sources of revenues received by the District Attorneys General, such as: grants, investment income, miscellaneous refunds, contributions, and other local revenues.

Drug Task Force Fund

Some judicial districts have established multi-jurisdictional drug task forces under the leadership of the district attorneys general. These drug task forces were created by contract (mutual aid agreement) between the participating district attorneys general and city and county governments, and were approved by their respective legislative bodies. Each judicial district drug task force, which generally includes sheriffs and police chiefs of participating law enforcement agencies within each judicial district, is governed by a board of directors.

Drug task force funds should be deposited with the county trustee in the county of each district attorney general's residence or another county designated by the district attorney general. The county trustees should credit these funds to the Judicial District Drug Fund.

All nonconfidential financial operations should be expended through these Judicial District Drug funds under the administration of the county mayors/executives. The directors of the drug task forces should submit requisitions to the county mayors/executives for goods and services, which would then be obtained through the county's purchasing system. Cash transactions for confidential funds should be requisitioned and disbursed under the supervision of each drug task force director and chairman.

Federal Asset Forfeiture Fund

In 1984, the United States Department of Justice enacted the Comprehensive Crime Control Act, which gave the Office of U.S. Attorney General the authority to share federally forfeited property with cooperating state and local law enforcement agencies. The three primary goals of the Justice Department's forfeiture program are 1) to punish and deter criminal activity by depriving criminals of property used for or acquired through illegal activities; 2) to enhance cooperation among federal, state, and local law enforcement agencies through equitable sharing of assets recovered through the program; and 3) to procure revenues to enhance forfeitures and strengthen law enforcement.

Through an agreement with the United States Department of Justice and the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA), the Office of District Attorney General of the Thirtieth Judicial District is participating in this forfeiture program. Under this agreement, the District Attorney General's Office has assigned to the Drug Task Force (DTF) an officer who is under the direct supervision and control of DEA supervisory personnel. Upon request by the District Attorney General's Office, DEA reimburses for overtime payments made to the The District Attorney General's Office deposits these officer assigned to the DTF. reimbursements with the Shelby County financial director, who channels the funds through Shelby County's General Fund. Also, under this agreement, the District Attorney General's Office requests from DEA its share of property recovered through joint law enforcement activities in which the officer assigned to the DTF participates. Payments received are deposited with the Shelby County Trustee's Office into the U.S. District Attorney General Federal Asset Forfeiture Fund. Pursuant to the Department of Justice's policy, funds made available through this program must be used by the District Attorney General's Office for law enforcement purposes.

Through an agreement with the Internal Revenue Service, the Office of District Attorney General of the Twentieth Judicial District also participates in the forfeiture program. Payments received by the Twentieth Judicial District are deposited to a separate fund in Metro-Nashville Davidson County and must be used for law enforcement purposes.

Metro/County Appropriations Fund

The Metro/County Appropriations Fund consists of funds appropriated by the counties and cities in the Twentieth and Twenty-third Judicial Districts.

Mediation Services Fund

The Mediation Services Fund consists of funds received from a one dollar litigation tax that is assessed on all cases in the General Sessions and Juvenile Courts in Davidson County and other appropriations received by the Twentieth Judicial District for the support and operation of victim-offender mediation centers.

Other Funds

Other funds in the Thirtieth Judicial District consist of funds raised from contributions from the City of Memphis to enhance a witness protection program (Witness Relocation Fund), donations received from various groups to promote initiatives to increase the quality

of life in certain communities located in Shelby County (Broken Window Fund), and certain forfeited funds (White Collar Crime Fund).

BASIS OF ACCOUNTING

The various governmental funds are accounted for using the modified accrual basis of accounting.

FINANCIAL SUMMARY

Total revenues and expenditures of these funds for the 31 judicial districts, as well as beginning and ending balances for the year examined, are presented below:

SCOPE

The reviews include an examination of funds administered by the district attorneys general for the year ended June 30, 2011. In addition, the reviews include an examination of the administration of judicial district drug task force funds by the Drug Task Forces' Boards of Directors for the year ended June 30, 2011. Our reviews consisted of tests of records and auditing procedures that we considered necessary in the circumstances.

Findings and recommendations, as a result of our reviews, are presented in the Findings, Recommendations, and Financial Section of this report. Five judicial districts had material findings. We reviewed these findings and recommendations with the district attorneys general and representatives of the Drug Task Forces to provide an opportunity for their response. The written responses from the District Attorney Generals and/or Drug Task Force Directors of the Third, Tenth, Eighteenth, and Twenty-fourth Judicial Districts are included in this report. Other officials made oral responses; however, these oral responses have not been included in this report.

THIRD JUDICIAL DISTRICT

THIRD JUDICIAL DISTRICT

It should be noted that based on weaknesses noted during our review of the Judicial District Drug Task Force, along with difficulties we encountered in obtaining the records and documentation needed to complete our review, we extended our review procedures to include operations through March 5, 2012. The management's response is a written response received from the district attorney general of the Third Judicial District.

FINDING 11.01 THE DRUG TASK FORCE HAD ACCOUNTING AND FINANCIAL DEFICIENCIES

Accounting and financial deficiencies existed in the Drug Task Force (DTF). These deficiencies appear to have been the result of a lack of oversight by management of the DTF. These deficiencies included:

- A. A fund deficit of \$10,810 existed in the Drug Task Force as of June 30, 2011, and cash on deposit with the Greene County Trustee was \$66, while fund liabilities totaled \$27,598. It should be noted that included in the \$27,598 liability is a \$10,000 loan from the Greene County Drug Control Fund that was used to provide cash flow.
- B. A cash deficit of \$22,804 existed in the Judicial District Drug Fund as of February 29, 2012. The cash deficit resulted from disbursements in excess of available funds on deposit with the Greene County Trustee. Also, contributing to this deficit was the DTF director's failure to remit the cash from various seizures awarded to the Greene County Trustee in a timely manner. See Finding No. 11.02 for more details.
- C. A bank overdraft of \$469 existed in the confidential funds bank account on November 30, 2010. This overdraft resulted from checks being issued in excess of available funds. Overdraft charges of \$32 were incurred as a result of the overdraft. The bank overdraft was liquidated in December 2010. It should be noted that a balance of \$40 existed in the confidential funds bank account as of June 30, 2011.
- D. Also, included in the \$27,598 liability reflected on June 30, 2011, was \$4,418 in past-due telephone bills and \$418 in late charges. These liabilities related to two service providers who had not been paid since March 10, 2011. The statements for one of the providers were not paid until February 10, 2012. Prior to the February 10, 2012, payment, the liability for the two providers had grown to \$7,584. Since some of these statements had not been opened as of March 6, 2012, it does not appear that the DTF director had reviewed the monthly billings in accordance with policies established by the DTF Board of Directors.

RECOMMENDATION

Management should liquidate any fund deficit and cash deficits. Steps should be taken to ensure that monies are not committed or disbursed unless sufficient funds are available.

Invoices should be paid in a timely manner to avoid late charges. The DTF director should review all monthly invoices for reasonableness and in accordance with policies established by the DTF Board of Directors.

FINDING 11.02 DEFICIENCIES WERE NOTED IN THE RECORDING AND MANAGEMENT OF SEIZED PROPERTY

Inventory logs for cash seized by Drug Task Force (DTF) personnel reflected a balance of \$66,916 as of June 30, 2011. Our review of a report of seized property obtained from the Tennessee Department of Safety (TDOS) noted that as of June 30, 2011, \$12,099 of the \$66,916 in seized cash had been awarded to the DTF by the TDOS prior to June 30, 2011; however, this \$12,099 had not been deposited with the Greene County trustee. Of the \$12,099 seized cash awarded, \$5,622 was deposited with the Greene County trustee on August 3, 2011, and \$6,477 was deposited March 13, 2012.

Our extended procedures disclosed that as of March 5, 2012, inventory logs for cash seized by the DTF reflected a balance of \$55,029. A report of seized property obtained from the TDOS noted that \$37,298 of the \$55,029 cash seizures had been awarded to the DTF but had not been deposited with the Greene County trustee. The DTF director deposited \$21,824 of these seized and awarded funds with the Greene County trustee on March 13, 2012.

An inventory log of vehicles seized by the DTF was maintained by the DTF director. However, we noted there were six additional vehicles that had been seized but not recorded in the inventory log. We noted at least 19 vehicles were reflected on the report of seized property obtained from the TDOS that had been awarded to the DTF but had not been properly recorded as assets of the DTF and had not been disposed of as of March 5, 2012.

We noted instances where personal property that had been seized was not listed in the evidence log. We were informed that since the evidence room was full, some property was being stored in multiple locations. Based on our review of the evidence room and discussions with various agents, it appears that this property has not been disposed of in a number of years.

RECOMMENDATION

Inventory logs for seizures of cash, vehicles, and personal property should be properly maintained. To improve cash flow, seized cash and funds received from the disposal of seized vehicles that have been awarded to the DTF should be deposited with the Greene County trustee in a timely manner. DTF personnel should perform a detailed examination of the evidence room to ensure the inventory log is accurate. For any evidence that is not required for further prosecution, DTF personnel should either return the property to the owner or solicit an award order and properly disburse the proceeds.

FINDING 11.03 ADEQUATE DOCUMENTATION WAS NOT MAINTAINED TO SUPPORT SOME CONFIDENTIAL EXPENDITURES

The following deficiencies were noted in the documentation maintained to support confidential expenditures of the Drug Task Force (DTF):

- A. In some instances, the DTF director did not provide us with the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation's (TBI) lab reports. These lab reports are used to support the disbursement of confidential funds for undercover drug purchases. The director did not provide these lab reports in 17 of the 27 disbursements selected for testing.
- B. Payments to confidential informants were recorded on the agent's activity logs and supported with documentation. However, the documentation did not always include a witness signature. In addition, certain payments were not always properly posted to the confidential informants' payment history log. The deficiencies noted with the logs included: (1) one payment history log could not be located, (2) two instances were noted where the payment was not posted to the payment history log, and (3) one payment amount recorded on the history log differed with the agent's activity log by \$40.
- C. The agents are required to submit their cash and activity log to the DTF director twice a month for the director to count the cash and reconcile the cash with amounts reflected on the agents' activity logs and to sign and date the logs. There was no signature or date on the agents' activity logs for the period July 1, 2011, through January 31, 2012, which indicates that the director had not reviewed and approved the activity logs as required by DTF policy.
- D. One instance was noted where a receipt was not on file to support a cash disbursement of \$20 recorded on the agent's activity log. Another instance was noted where a receipt was on file to support a cash disbursement of \$17; however, a business name was not present on the receipt.
- E. A bank account is maintained by the DTF director to account for certain confidential transactions. Based on our review, there was no indication that the bank statements were reconciled with the accounting records. Additionally, certain bank statements were not on file or provided to us by the director, even after several requests were made. Ultimately we were able to obtain the needed statements through other sources.

RECOMMENDATION

Tennessee Bureau of Investigation lab reports should be maintained to substantiate the disbursement of funds for all undercover drug purchases. All payments to confidential informants should be supported with a witness signature. Confidential informants' payment history logs should be properly maintained and periodically reconciled with the individual agents' activity logs. Agents' cash should be counted twice a month and reconciled with the agents' activity logs. The director should sign and date the logs twice

each month. All confidential expenditures should be properly and accurately documented. All bank statements should be maintained on file and reconciled timely with the accounting records.

FINDING 11.04 DEFICIENCIES WERE NOTED IN THE RECEIPTING AND DEPOSITING OF FUNDS

The Drug Task Force (DTF) director issued receipts for cash settlements and withdrawals from the Judicial District Drug Fund. Cash settlements were deposited with the Greene County Trustee, and funds withdrawn from the Judicial District Drug Fund were deposited to a confidential funds bank account maintained by the DTF director. The following deficiencies were noted:

- A. In two instances, cash was obtained at the time checks from the Judicial District Drug Fund were deposited into the confidential funds bank account in-lieu-of depositing all of the checks then issuing an official check to obtain the cash. A withdrawal was not recorded by the bank, and only the net amount of the deposit was recognized on the bank statement. The remaining cash was recorded in the director's custodial log.
- B. Five instances were noted where receipts were deposited as long as 20 days after the receipt date. Section 5-8-207, *Tennessee Code Annotated*, requires all public funds be deposited within three days of collection.
- C. Receipts were not always issued at the time of collection. Two instances were noted where the receipt dates were after the deposit date. The practice of issuing receipts subsequent to the actual collection defeats the purpose of the receipt.
- D. A refund check from a phone service provider totaling \$21.11 dated December 13, 2011, was discovered in an unopened envelope on March 6, 2012. The director was not aware of the check until we brought it to his attention.

RECOMMENDATION

All deposits to the confidential funds bank account should be recognized for the full amount of the checks, and an official check should be issued to obtain cash. Receipts should be deposited in tact and within three days of collection as required by state statute. Receipts should be issued at the time of collection. Procedures should be developed to ensure that mail is opened timely.

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FINDING 11.05 PURCHASES WERE NOT MADE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE COUNTY'S PURCHASING PROCEDURES

Nonconfidential purchases were made from the Judicial District Drug Fund maintained by the Greene County Office of Accounts and Budgets; however, certain purchases were not made in accordance with the county's purchasing procedures. The following deficiencies were noted:

- A. In some instances, purchase orders were not issued. Purchase orders are necessary to control who has purchasing authority and to document purchasing commitments.
- B. Some purchase orders were issued after the purchases were made. This practice defeats the purpose of the purchase order and makes it an approval of payment rather than approval of the purchase.
- C. One instance was noted where the description of the items on the purchase order differed from the items listed on the receipt. We also noted one instance where a set of wheels and tires were purchased; however, neither the invoice nor the subsequently issued purchase order reflected what vehicle the wheels and tires were for.
- D. Subsequent to June 30, 2011, we noted four instances where 46 inkjet printer cartridges were purchased totaling \$2,786 including shipping and handling costs of \$402. Purchase orders were not obtained for these purchases. In addition, a total of \$100 in Subway Restaurant gift cards were received as promotional items. As of March 9, 2012, the gift cards had not been accounted for.

RECOMMENDATION

Nonconfidential purchases should be made in accordance with Greene County's purchasing procedures. To strengthen internal controls over purchasing procedures and to document purchasing commitments, purchase orders should be issued for all applicable purchases before purchases are made and should include an accurate description of the items. The director should review all statements for accuracy. Any promotional items should be accounted for properly.

FINDING 11.06 EQUIPMENT INVENTORY CONTROL RECORDS WERE NOT PROPERLY MAINTAINED

Equipment inventory records were not properly maintained. A control listing of equipment and a subsidiary listing of vehicles were maintained; however, certain items that were included on the subsidiary listing were not included on the equipment control listing. Also, vehicle identification numbers were not included on the subsidiary listing of vehicles.

RECOMMENDATION

Internal controls over equipment should be strengthened. A control listing of equipment that includes all necessary information should be maintained and reconciled with the subsidiary listing. Equipment should be periodically verified by management.

FINDING 11.07 REQUIRED REPORTS WERE NOT SUBMITTED IN A TIMELY MANNER

On March 24, 2011, the State of Tennessee, Department of Finance and Administration, Resource Development and Support, Office of Criminal Justice Programs released its monitoring report for the Third Judicial District Drug Task Force. The results of that monitoring disclosed that reports were not submitted in a timely manner. The Quarterly Income Summary Report for the 2011 fiscal year had not been submitted. The Quarterly Performance Measurement Report for the first quarter was not submitted timely. The report due date was October 15, 2010, but the report was submitted on October 29, 2010.

The monitoring report along with management's response and corrective action plan may be obtained from the state Department of Finance and Administration, Resource Development and Support, Office of Criminal Justice Programs, William R. Snodgrass Tennessee Tower Office Building, Suite 1200, 312 Rosa L. Parks Avenue, Nashville, TN 37243-1102.

MANAGEMENT'S RESPONSE TO ALL FINDINGS – DISTRICT ATTORNEY GENERAL

Thank you very much for your thorough audit of the Third Judicial District Drug Task Force. I have reviewed your findings of our current deficiencies, and I am in complete agreement with them. Each recommendation has been or is in the process of being implemented as expeditiously as possible. The entire process will be facilitated by the imminent selection of a new director of the Drug Task Force. The former director has been reassigned to a position with the Hawkins County Sheriff's Department.

FINDING 11.01 THE DRUG TASK FORCE HAD UNALLOWABLE COSTS OF \$15,227 RELATED TO THE AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT

The Drug Task Force (DTF) was notified on September 30, 2010, by the Office of Criminal Justice Programs (OCJP) that supplanting had occurred with regard to the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) Justice Assistance Grant (JAG). Federal grants cannot be used to replace state or local funds that would, in the absence of federal aid, be available or forthcoming for law enforcement. The DTF transferred an agent to the ARRA JAG-funded position on January 22, 2010, and did not fill the DTF-funded position that the agent had been in before transferring until June 1, 2010. As a result, the OCJP calculated unallowable costs of \$15,227 and requested a refund of \$3,792, which the DTF paid on October 26, 2010. The refund was derived as follows:

FINDING 11.01 A FORFEITURE WARRANT WAS NOT OBTAINED FROM THE COURT

On February 2, 2012, agents seized drugs, drug paraphernalia, and \$421 in cash. Although the seizure was documented on the appropriate forms, a forfeiture warrant was never obtained from the court. The agent in charge of the seizure was in the process of turning over his responsibilities to other agents because he was having surgery. The Drug Task Force did not follow through on the seizure and was required to return the \$421 to the defendant.

RECOMMENDATION

All appropriate paperwork should be filed in court promptly.

<u>MANAGEMENT'S RESPONSE – DRUG AND VIOLENT CRIME TASK FORCE</u> DIRECTOR

I have reviewed this finding and I do understand; however, this was an isolated incident. The agent in charge was injured and required surgery, and the seizure was never completed. This error has been documented, and the \$421 was returned to the defendant in a timely manner. Steps have been taken to correct this from happening in the future.

FINDING 11.02

AN ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEY (ADA) USED A DRUG TASK FORCE (DTF) FUEL CARD TO FUEL HIS PERSONAL VEHICLE USED FOR OFFICIAL BUSINESS IN-LIEU-OF PERSONALLY PURCHASING THE FUEL AND FILING ITEMIZED EXPENSE CLAIMS FOR REIMBURSEMENT

We received an allegation that an ADA of the Tenth District Attorney General's Office was using a DTF fuel card to fuel his personal vehicle. During our examination of this allegation, the district attorney general advised us that the ADA exclusively prosecuted DTF cases, and that the ADA used his personal vehicle for official business in-lieu-of driving a vehicle owned by the task force. Also, we were advised at the DTF and through our analysis of records maintained at the McMinn County Finance Office for the DTF that no documentation was on file to support a breakdown of the ADA's vehicle use mileage between personal business and official business. Our examination disclosed from February 11, 2010 through January 25, 2012, the ADA charged a total of \$4,091 on the DTF fuel card used in his personal vehicle. Section 8-26-109, *Tennessee Code Annotated*, requires government employees who are authorized to incur official expenses, which are to be paid by the government, to file itemized expense accounts showing the date and amount of each separate item and the purpose for which it was expended. The failure to account for a division of personal business and official business use mileage could lead to an abuse of fuel purchased.

To address this deficiency, on March 1, 2012, the DTF adopted a policy requiring employees to submit mileage reimbursement claims when using personal vehicles in-lieu-of using the DTF fuel card.

RECOMMENDATION

Itemized reimbursement claims should be submitted when using personally owned vehicles for official business as required by state statute.

MANAGEMENT'S RESPONSE – DISTRICT ATTORNEY GENERAL

As noted in the finding, the DTF immediately corrected this deficiency when it was brought to their attention.

FINDING 11.01 THE DRUG TASK FORCE HAD DEFICIENCIES IN THE USE OF FEDERAL FUNDS

On May 12, 2011, the State of Tennessee, Department of Finance and Administration, Office of Criminal Justice Programs released a monitoring report on the Recovery Act-Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program/ Grants to States and Territories for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011. The results of that monitoring disclosed the following deficiencies:

- A. The Eighteenth Judicial District Attorney General's Office did not submit invoices for reimbursement quarterly. First and second quarter reimbursement requests for grant expenses incurred from July 2010 to September 2010 and from October 2010 to December 2010 were submitted late on April 27, 2011.
- B. The agency did not submit the Quarterly Program Income Summary Report for the first quarter of the current fiscal year. The report was due on October 30, 2010.
- C. The Eighteenth Judicial District Attorney General's Office did not retain required documents. The agency was unable to produce copies of the ARRA Quarterly Jobs Data Reports for the second and third quarters of the current fiscal year.

This monitoring report along with management's responses and corrective action plans may be obtained from the state Department of Finance and Administration, Resource Development and Support, Office of Criminal Justice Programs, William R. Snodgrass Tennessee Tower Office Building, Suite 1200, 312 Rosa L. Parks Avenue, Nashville, Tennessee 37243-1102.

MANAGEMENT'S RESPONSE – DRUG TASK FORCE DIRECTOR

- A. Our agency is aware that invoices for reimbursement should be submitted at least quarterly. We believe that invoices for October 2010 and January 2011 were timely submitted, but do not have documentation to support it. We now have implemented new procedures and additional personnel to document and keep a hard copy of each submitted invoice and all related correspondence. Invoices will be submitted monthly if expenses are incurred and no less frequently than quarterly at any rate.
- B. This report would have been submitted during a time when the state computer system was experiencing network problems and the Drug Task Force computer was not downloading and saving proper files that were transmitted. The agency maintains that the report was completed and sent on time but cannot verify it by documentation. The problem has now been corrected, and there have been no problems since our software was updated.

C.	Our agency agrees that all records pertinent to the award should be retained. All records and documentation relating to the award are now being retained by hard copy in the grant file.

FINDING 11.01 THE DRUG TASK FORCE HAD A CASH SHORTAGE OF \$5,565 AT JUNE 30, 2011

The Drug Task Force had a cash shortage of \$5,565 at June 30, 2011. This cash shortage includes \$4,065, which we reported in Finding 09.01 in the Review of Funds Administered by District Attorneys General at June 30, 2009, plus an additional \$1,500 we reported in Finding 10.02 in the Review of Funds Administered by the District Attorney General - Twenty-fourth Judicial District at June 30, 2010. As of the date of this review, the \$5,565 cash shortage has not been liquidated.

RECOMMENDATION

Officials should take steps to liquidate the \$5,565 cash shortage.

MANAGEMENT'S RESPONSE – DRUG TASK FORCE DIRECTOR

While we agree that the funds mentioned in Finding 11.01 are indeed missing, we also feel that all steps available to us to locate the funds have been exhausted. Additionally, Attorney General McCadams reported that the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation and the special prosecutor are continuing to investigate the loss of these funds and other matters pertaining to our situation.
