**RE:** Phase-In Proposal from the Hill City Parent Coalition

The Hill City Parent Coalition proposes the adoption of a phase-in plan that would allow the Hill City neighborhood to be fully included into the Normal Park Zone over the course of 16 years.

This plan calls for the phase-in of one school grade from Hill City into the Normal Park School Zone every other year. Any Hill City family with older children enrolled at Red Bank Elementary would have the option to enroll their Kindergartner there, in order to allow siblings to stay at the same school.

The proposed phase-in plan would be implemented as follows:
