On Thursday, January 17, 2013 at around 0255 hours I was sitting in the Waffle House parking lot located at 102 Signal Mountain Road, Red Bank, TN when a gold Ford Ranger started spinning its tires and then it drove over the curve across the rocks and back onto Signal Mountain Road facing east, the Ranger then pulled up to the red light at Dayton Boulevard and

stopped.

I pulled out of the Waffle House parking lot onto Dayton Boulevard going north and stopped at the red light at Signal Mountain Road. The gold Ranger pull onto Dayton Boulevard from Signal Mountain Road now traveling north on Dayton Boulevard. I pulled in behind the Ranger and ran the tag it was TN A1734U, the Ranger also didn't have any headlights on and was driving between the lines in the slow and fast lane. I turned on my blue lights and siren in the 1800 block of Dayton Boulevard and the Ranger continued on and stopped in the parking lot of 1998 Dayton Boulevard.

Identified the driver as Richard T. Glover. Mr. Grover had a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage about his person and breath, Mr. Glover had glassy eyes and very slurred speech. I ask Mr. Glover to step from the Ranger and ask if he would do some field sobriety test and he agreed. Mr. Glover was very unsteady getting out of the Ranger, I tried the Horizontal Gage Nystagmus test he couldn't follow instructions, I then tried the one leg stand and held up his right foot for two seconds and put his foot down and said I can't do any of your test.

Mr. Glover advised he wanted to leave his vehicle secured there on the parking lot of 1998 Dayton Boulevard, I told Mr. Glover he would have to sign a no tow request and he said he would. Sgt. Knight and I did an inventory of the truck, and while inventorying it we could smell a very strong odor of marijuana. Sgt. Knight ask Mr. Glover how much marijuana have you smoked in the truck tonight, he replied not that much.

I did place Mr. Glover under arrest at this time for D.U.I. upon arrival to the Red Bank Police Station I ask Mr. Glover If he wished to take the Intoximeter test and he advised no he didn't want to take the test and signed the refusal.

Mr. Glover was then taken to the Hamilton County Jail. I did locate one open container of alcohol on the cup holder of the Ranger. Mr. Glover was very cooperative and gave no trouble.

Mr. Glover did have a forced blood draw taken at the Hamilton County Jail because he had been arrested and convicted of a prior D.U.I. in 1987 in Hamilton County.
