FOR HIS CONVICTION in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Tennessee on an information (Docket No. 11,569) charging violation of Section 500, Title 18, United States Code, for which he was sentenced on June twenty-seventh, 1961, to eighteen months' probation.

THE PRESIDENT HAS DESIGNATED, directed and empowered the Pardon Attorney as his representative to sign this grant of executive clemency.

The pathway provided through an Attorney General's referral to the State of Tennessee's Pardon Committee, is not viable due to no allocation of funding for the Committee to be convened.


Mr. Grimes was convicted 50 years ago in 1960 when he was 20 years of age.
