The Judicial Liaison will work directly with judges and the courts to lead education and implementation of our justice reinvestment initiative. Justice reinvestment is our ongoing effort to ensure we do our part to manage the offender population through evidence-based practices and community alternatives. This will allow us to reserve our most expensive supervision alternative (prison beds) for those who pose the greatest risk to society.
