We the members of the City Council would like to request a full briefing at the City Attorney Meeting on Tuesday, March 4th at 2:00 p.m. regarding the current evaluation of the Global Green Lighting Initiative within the City of Chattanooga.

In October of 2013, your office stated that a full evaluation would take place once the initial 6100 lights were installed. It was noted that it would require a full month of evaluation before a complete assessment of the quality and success of this project would be available. Furthermore, it was indicated that the installations were to be have been completed by the end of 2013.

We, as a Council wish to take swift action on this initiative and feel that we must be fully apprised of the current evaluation before entering into record our own ordinance on this matter or presenting a budget amendment to address this urgent issue.
