COUNT 1

The Grand Jurors upon their oath do present that

MICHAEL YOUNGER AND TWANNA "TART" BLAIR

on or about the 13th day of February, 1999, in Bradley County, Tennessee, and in Monroe County, Tennessee, and before the finding of this indictment, as members and participants of a drug dealing organization under the direction and control of Maurice Johnson, and while engaged in a drug turf war with Oriental James Blair, aka "OJ" Blair, did unlawfully, intentionally, or knowingly, agree and conspire amongst themselves, Maurice Johnson and others unknown that one or more of them would engage in conduct that constitutes the offense of first degree murder in Bradley County, Tennessee, with each having the culpable mental state required for the commission of that offense, and with each acting for the purpose of promoting or facilitating the commission of the offense, and in furtherance of the conspiracy to protect the drug dealing business of Maurice Johnson did engage in one or more of the following overt acts: On February 14, 1999, MICHAEL YOUNGER entered the apartment of TWANNA BLAIR at 431 19th Street NE and murdered Oriental James Blair, aka "OJ" Blair and defendants agreed to conceal the identity of the co-conspirators, in violation of T.C.A. 39-12-103, all of which is against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee. The statute of limitation for this offense and lesser included offenses is tolled from March 26, 2008, until December 17, 2010, by then-pending indictments numbers 08-125 and 08-455 in the Criminal Court of Bradley County, Tennessee.

COUNT 2

The Grand Jurors upon their oath do present that

MICHAEL YOUNGER AND TWANNA "TART" BLAIR

on or about the 13th day of February, 1999, in Bradley County, Tennessee, and before the finding of this indictment, did unlawfully, intentionally, or knowingly, agree and conspire amongst themselves and others known and unknown that one or more of them would engage in conduct that constitutes the offense of first degree murder, with each having the culpable mental state required for the commission of that offense, and with each acting for the purpose of promoting or facilitating the commission of the offense, and in furtherance of the conspiracy did engage in one or more of the following overt acts: On February 14, 1999, MICHAEL YOUNGER entered the apartment of TWANNA BLAIR at 431 19th Street NE and murdered Oriental James Blair, aka "OJ" Blair and defendants agreed to conceal the identity of the co-conspirators in violation of T.C.A. 39-12-103, all of which is against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee. The statute of limitation for this offense and lesser included offenses is tolled from March 26, 2008, until December 17, 2010, by then-pending indictments numbers 08-125 and 08-455 in the Criminal Court of Bradley County, Tennessee.

COUNT 3

And the Grand Jurors upon their oath do further present that

MICHAEL YOUNGER AND TWANNA "TART" BLAIR

on or about the 14th day of February, 1999, in Bradley County, Tennessee, and before the finding of this indictment, did unlawfully, intentionally, or knowingly, agree and conspire among themselves and others known and unknown that one or more of them would engage in conduct that constitutes the offense of an especially aggravated robbery, with each having the culpable mental state required for the commission of that offense, and with each acting for the purpose of promoting or facilitating the commission of the offense, and in furtherance of the conspiracy did engage in one or more of the following overt acts: Michael Younger entered the apartment of TWANNA BLAIR at 431 19th Street NE and did rob and murder Oriental James Blair, aka "OJ" Blair and agreed to conceal the identity of the defendants and their actions until March 6, 2006, in violation of T.A. 39-12-103, all of which is against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee. The statute of limitation for this offense and lesser included offenses is tolled from March 26, 2008, until December 17, 2010, by then-pending indictments numbers 08-125 and 08-455 in the Criminal Court of Bradley County, Tennessee.

COUNT 4

And the Grand Jurors upon their oath do further present that

MICHAEL YOUNGER

on or about the 14th day of February, 1999, in Bradley County, Tennessee, and before the finding of this indictment, did unlawfully and intentionally and knowingly, obtain property to-wit: money and property of Oriental James Blair, aka "OJ" Blair and without Oriental James Blair aka "OJ" Blair's effective consent, from the person of Oriental James Blair, aka "OJ" Blair by violence and accomplished by the use of a deadly weapon, to-wit: a gun, as a result of which Oriental James Blair, aka "OJ" Blair suffered serious bodily injury or death, in violation of T.C.A. 39-13-403, all of which is against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

COUNT 5

And the Grand Jurors upon their oath do further present that

MICHAEL YOUNGER

on or about the 14th day of February, 1999, in Bradley County, Tennessee, and before the finding of this indictment, did unlawfully and intentionally and with premeditation kill Oriental James Blair, aka "OJ" Blair, in violation of T.C.A. 39-13-202, all of which is against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

The statute of limitation for this offense and lesser included offenses is tolled from March 26, 2008, until December 17, 2010, by then-pending indictments numbers 08-125 and 08-455 in the Criminal Court of Bradley County, Tennessee.

on or about the 14th day of February, 1999, in Bradley County, Tennessee, and before the finding of this indictment, did unlawfully, knowing that that MICHAEL YOUNGER intended to commit a felony, to-wit: first degree murder of Dawn Rogers, but without the intent required for criminal responsibility under T.C.A. 39-11-402(2), knowingly and intentionally furnished substantial assistance in the commission of the said felony, to-wit: first degree murder in violation of T.C.A. 39-11-403, all of which is against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee. The statute of limitation for this offense and lesser included offenses is tolled from March 26, 2008, until December 17, 2010, by then-pending indictments numbers 08-125 and 08-455 in the Criminal Court of Bradley County, Tennessee.

COUNT 12

And the Grand Jurors upon their oath do further present that

TWANNA "TART" BLAIR

on or about the 14th day of February, 1999, in Bradley County, Tennessee, and before the finding of this indictment, did unlawfully, knowing that MICHAEL YOUNGER intended to commit a felony, to-wit: first degree murder of Cayci Higgins, but without the intent required for criminal responsibility under T.C.A. 39-11-402(2), knowingly and intentionally furnished substantial assistance in the commission of the said felony, to-wit: first degree murder in violation of T.C.A. 39-11-403, all of which is against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee. The statute of limitation for this offense and lesser included offenses is tolled from March 26, 2008, until December 17, 2010, by then-pending indictments numbers 08-125 and 08-455 in the Criminal Court of Bradley County, Tennessee.
