

AFFIDAVIT OF COMPLAINT

IN THE GENERAL SESSIONS COURT OF HAMILTON COUNTY.

STATE OF TENNESSEE VS. Arron Roden

The undersigned affiant, after being duly sworn according to the law, states that Arron Roden

whose name is otherwise unknown to the affiant, committed the offense of Aggravated Assault

in the above county on or about August 12th, 2014

Further, affiant makes oath that the essential facts constituting said offense, the sources of affiant's information,

and the reasons why his / her information is believable concerning said facts are as follows:

On 8/12/14 I, Dep. Hogan 2571 was called to 9629 East Brainard road at West view Elementary on a Burglary Alarm. Upon arrival I started my perimeter check of the school starting on the southern side. As I proceeded to walk past a double exit door I could see the silhouette of a person in the hallway. The subject was a white male and was vandalizing the interior of the school. I observed him breaking ceiling tiles and trying to kick in a door. He then picked up a fire extinguisher and started to spray the interior of the hallway. The subject then saw me through the door and he proceeded to start to run at me. He then stopped and pulled another fire extinguisher off the wall and threw it through the glass door at me. The extinguisher crashed through the window and I had to dodge it to keep it from hitting me. The subject then ran off down the hallway out of sight.

I immediately called for additional units to help secure the building. East 2 and a Collegdale unit arrived on scene and took to the back of the school to help contain. Myself and Lt. D. Wilson (Central 22) gained access with a set of keys from the county maintenance. Myself and Wilson entered through the side door and proceeded down the main hallway. Noises could be heard coming from the far end of the building. We were able to trace the noises to a conference room. The first door we came to was locked and several attempts were made to gain entry through each time we meet with return of beating on the door from the other side. Another access door to the conference room was located from the library side. Lt. Wilson attempted to open the door but was hampered by the fact that the subject had moved all the furniture in the room in front of the doors to the conference room. Several pushes were made to the door before there was enough room to gain entry. The subject was observed in the far corner of the room with only boxers on. He was hanging from a TV holder that was secured to the rafters. He stopped swinging from the TV and picked up a white printer and began to yell at deputies.

Commands were given for him to get on the ground. He made no such effort to comply. Lt. Wilson then tazed the subject. The subject then threw the printer at deputies heads as we tried to push our way further into the room. The tazer took enough effect to cause the subject to drop to the ground. LT. Wilson then handed me the tazer and proceeded to roll the subject over and place him into handcuffs.

The subject was frantic and sweating heavily. Myself and Wilson had to carry the subject out of the room and had to lay him on the floor because he would not walk any further. He was sweating so hard that we were not able to carry him or pick him up. He was leaned against the wall until Medic 5 got on scene to evaluate and remove any probs.



The subject was identified as Arron Roden(7/30/92). He was transported to Erlanger hospital for medical evaluation. While he was being prepped for the ride in he advised through excited utterances that his intent was "to do as much damage to the school as possible and then burn it down."

School officials estimated the damage value at over 60,000 dollars.
