




IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that both parties reserve the right to petition either this Court or the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Georgia for additional stays or to extend the stay of this action based upon the Bankruptcy filing and that both parties also reserve the right to object or oppose any attempts to impose additional stays or extend the period of the stay of these proceedings.


