In the Magistrate Court of Catoosa County
State of Georgia

The undersigned Det. Scott W. Jordan, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

I am an officer of the State of Georgia or its political subdivision charged with the duty of enforcing the criminal laws, and that I have reason to believe that in Catoosa County, Georgia, on the person, premises, or property described as follows:

1179 Potts Road Ringgold Catoosa Georgia, described as wood framed "A" framed structure with a brown asphalt shingle roof. The structure has wood siding and is trimmed in white. There is a black mailbox at the road in front of the residence clearly marked with numbers 1179.

There is now located certain instruments, articles, person(s), or things, namely:

Fuji S100 serial number 642HGS the property of Catoosa County which contains Photographic evidence, to substantiate the offense of Violation of the Georgia Controlled Substance act ie: Possession of Schedule II Methamphetamine.

Which is being possessed in violation of Georgia Law.

OCGA 16-13-30 VGCSA: POSSESSION OF METHAMPHETAMINE

The facts tending to establish probable cause that a crime has been, or is being committed and the above described instruments, articles or things described above are presently located at the above described premises or property are as follows:

On February 13, 2015 Deputies and Detectives served Wesley Gage Weldon with a Temporary Protective Order. As ordered by the TPO any and all firearms in Weldon's possession were to be seized. During the search of the residence for firearms, found in plain view, a quantity of methamphetamine was located.

As a result of this discovery Mr. Weldon was arrested. When law enforcement left the residence a Catoosa County sheriff's Office owned Fuji S100 digital camera was mistakenly left behind. The camera contains images of the illegal substances, and tools for the commission of this crime. It is believed that the above mentioned camera is still in the residence.

For the above reasons, your affiant has probable cause to believe that there may now be contained in the residence: photographic evidence to substantiate the evidence for the offense of Violation of the Georgia Controlled Substances Act. .

I swear or affirm that all of the information contained in this Affidavit and all other testimony given by me under oath is true to the best of my knowledge and belief.


