Last year: Baxendale went 4-4 with a 6.02 earned run average in 11 starts at high Single-A Fort Myers and went 0-3 with a 5.76 in seven games (four starts) at Double-A New Britain.

RESIDES: Bayamon, Puerto Rico

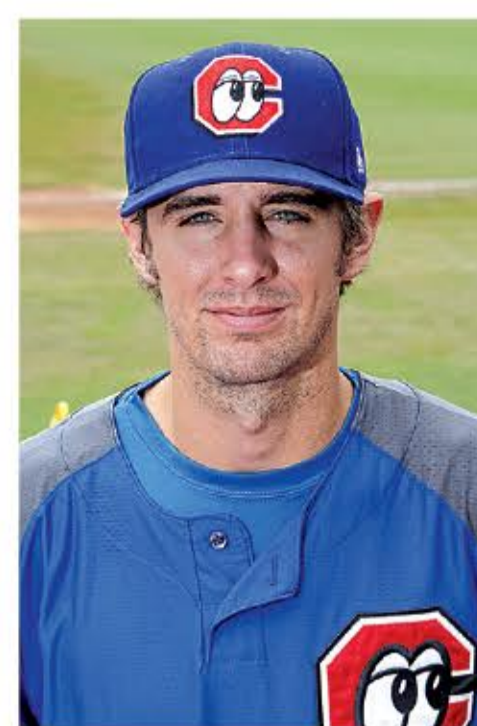

RESIDES: Houston, Texas

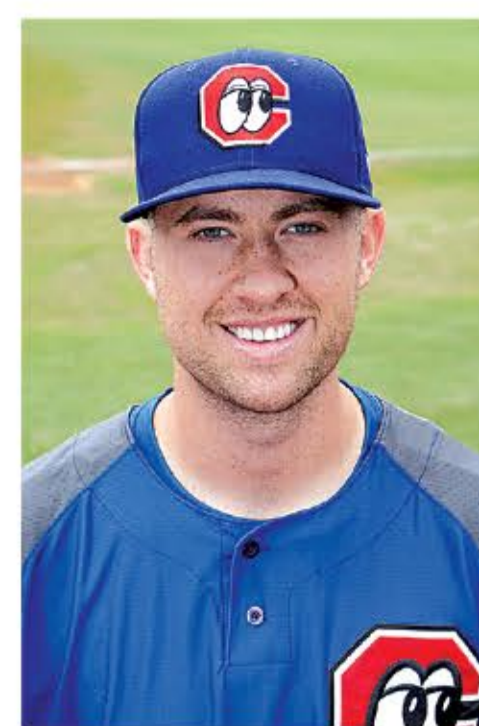

RESIDES: Vancouver, Wash.

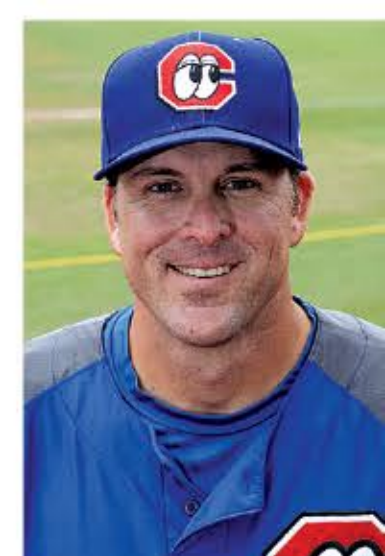

Last year: Burdi went 0-0 with a 4.15 ERA and 26 strikeouts in 13 games at Single-A Cedar Rapids and then was 2-0 with an 0.00 ERA and 12 strikeouts in seven games at Fort Myers.

Last year: Stuart was the primary catcher on the Florida State League championship team at Fort Myers. In 93 games, he posted a .249 average with seven home runs and 40 RBIs.

Last year: Gonzales hit .274 with nine home runs and 53 RBIs in 78 games at high Single-A Fort Myers before hitting .264 with 18 homers in 31 games at Double-A New Britain.

Last year: Polanco, a member of Minnesota's 40-man roster, hit .291 with six homers and 45 RBIs in 94 games with Fort Myers and batted .281 with 16 RBIs in 37 games with New Britain.



STEVE WICKENS

RESIDES: Ontario, Canada

Last year: Wickens produced a .310 batting average with one home run and 12 RBIs in 15 games with Fort Myers before going on to hit .217 with 12 RBIs in 57 contests with New Britain.



MIGUEL SANO

RESIDES: Dominican Republic

Last year: Sano, the No. 12 overall prospect according to MLB.com and a member of Minnesota's 40-man roster, did not play after amassing 103 RBIs with Fort Myers and New Britain in 2013.

RESIDES: Baxley, Ga.

Last year: Baseball's top prospect according to MLB.com and Baseball Prospectus suffered two wrist injuries and a concussion, which limited him to a .240 average in 30 games with Fort Myers.

RESIDES: Aliso Viejo, Calif.

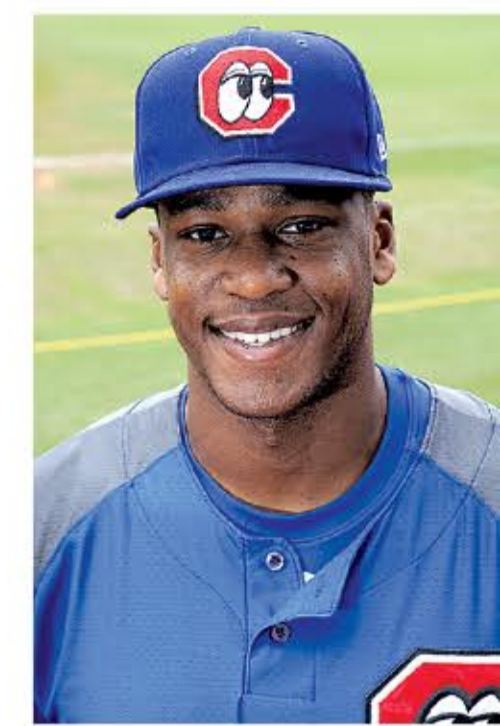
Last year: Harrison played in 129 games for the Florida State League champion Fort Myers Miracle, producing a .269 batting average with three home runs and 59 RBIs.

Last year: Kepler, a member of Minnesota's 40-man roster, played in 102 games for the Fort Myers Miracle. The German-born Kepler hit .264 with five home runs and 59 RBIs.

RESIDES: Milwaukee

Last year: Walker arrives in Chattanooga having played more games in Fort Myers, 132, than any Lookouts teammate. He had a .246 average with 25 homers and 94 RBIs.
