RESULTS:

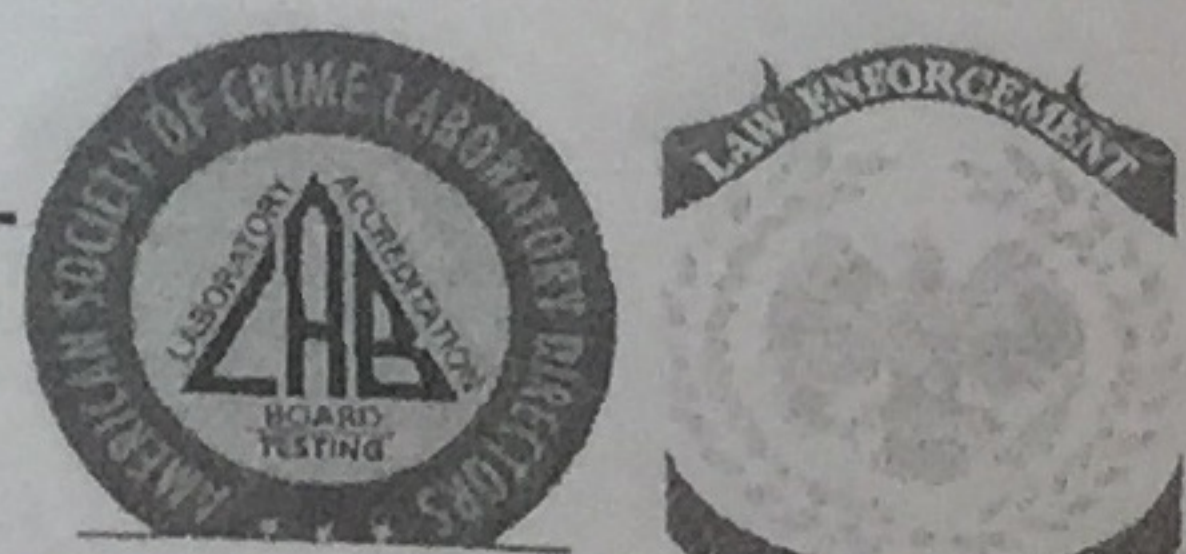
The previously developed latent palm prints (L-2, L-4, L-5, L-6, L-7, L-8, L-9, L-10, L-11, L-12, and L-13) from exhibits 01111885-1 (white Ford Crown Victoria) and 01111885-17 (flashlight) were searched against the State of Tennessee's Automated Fingerprint Identification System (AFIS) database. No identifications were made as a result of the searches; however, additional searches will be conducted as new known impressions are entered into the database.

The latent palm print L-3 is a duplicate print of L-2 and was not searched against the AFIS database.

The above listed latent palm prints were not applicable for entry into the Federal Integrated Automated Fingerprint Identification System (IAFIS) database.

One (1) previously developed latent print (L-1) from exhibit 01111885-1 (white Ford Crown Victoria - Driver's side, side of door frame) was compared to the known impressions of Donald Kenneth Bond, Jr. and Marlon Kaiser (DOB: 02/18/70) with the following results:

L-1: Identified to the left ring (#9) finger of


