Section by adding a section that allows any county within the State of Tennessee with a population of no more than 336,463 and no less than 336,400, according to the 2010 federal census or any subsequent federal census, to present a referendum to its voters as to whether to impose an additional one cent (1¢) tax levy on each cigarette, and an equivalent tax levy by volume of tobacco in other tobacco products, sold within that county with the proceeds from said tax being appropriated to support the operational expenses of arts or cultural organizations within said county.
