NOTICE OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE OF INTENTION TO SEEK THE
DEATH PENALTY

COMES NOW the State of Tennessee, by and through the offices of Stephen D. Crump, District Attorney General for the Tenth Judicial District, and pursuant to Rule 12.3 of the Tennessee Rules of Criminal Procedure and T.C.A. § 40-35-202(a), hereby gives notice to the Defendant, Ross Hamilton Anderson, that the State of Tennessee intends to ask for the death penalty in this case. At the sentencing hearing, if any, in this matter the State intends to rely upon the following aggravating circumstances codified in Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-13-204(i):

- (1) **The murder was committed against a person less than twelve (12) years of age and the defendant was eighteen (18) years of age or older;**

- (6) **The murder was committed for the purpose of avoiding, interfering with, or preventing a lawful arrest or prosecution of the defendant or another;**
