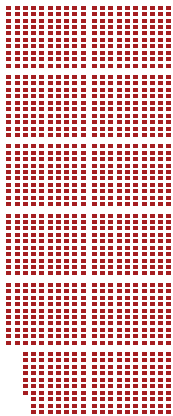
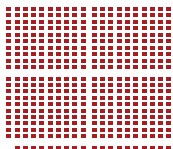

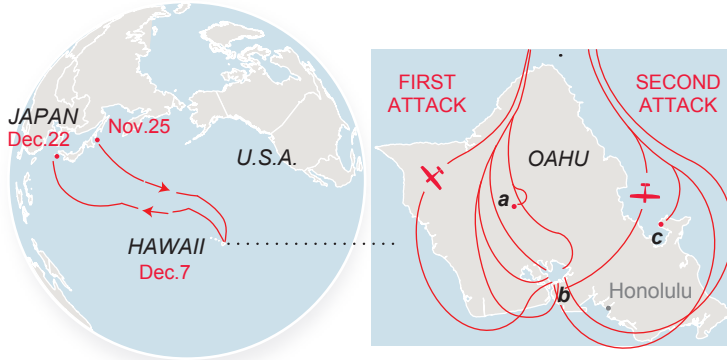

Day of Infamy

THE ASSAULT THAT THRUST AMERICA INTO WORLD WAR II

The surprise strike on Pearl Harbor, 75 years ago on December 7, was the worst day in the U.S. Navy's history. Japanese aircraft attacked Oahu, Hawaii, along with other U.S.-held targets in the Pacific region.



JAPANESE AIRCRAFT ATTACKED IN TWO WAVES

352 aircraft, fighters, bombers, and torpedo planes, hit 19 U.S. vessels, including 8 battleships, 3 destroyers and 3 cruisers.
