**NARRATIVE**

On above date Sheriff's Office received a call of a shooting at the Golden Gallon at Rocky Face, at three minutes after midnight. The first car arrived at six minutes after midnight. Upon arrival Officers found Ernest Griffin lying in the parking lot with a gunshot wound to the head. Mary Burli son was inside the store, she was shot three times. Both victims were transported to Hamilton Medical Center by Dalton Ambulance. Mr. Griffin was D.O.A. Mrs. Burli son was admitted to hospital. Statement taken from Mrs. Burlinson stated that her and Mr. Griffin were walking out of the store when she saw her husband, Jay Burli son pull up behind Mr. Griffin's car, as he was getting in it. She ran to her car and then seen Jay shooting at Mr. Griffin. Then he came over to her car and shot her three times through her window.
