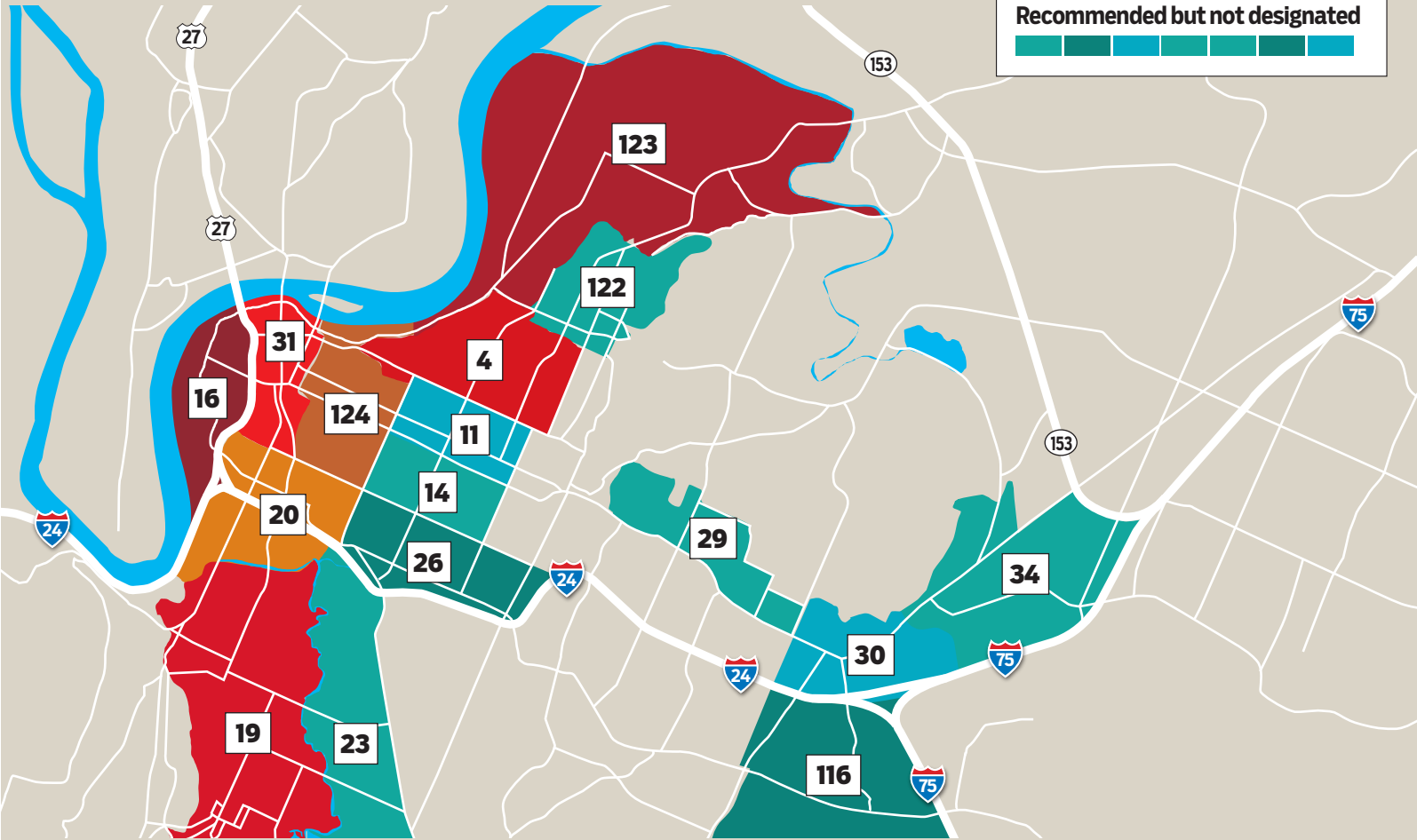


Hamilton County Opportunity Zones

The Tax Cuts and Job Act requires that designated tracts have either a median family income at or below 80 percent of the area median income or a poverty rate of 20 percent or greater. Additional tracts were eligible if they met a certain migration threshold, contained an Empowerment Zone, a Clinton-era federal economic development tool, or were contiguous to a qualifying low-income tract.
