On 12/1/2018 at approximately 1901 hours, Collegedale Officers were dispatched to the area of Tucker Road and Homewood subdivision on a report of a white hatchback like vehicle, with a drive out tag, throwing fireworks out of the vehicle while it was in motion.

Officer Long arrived in the area around 1904 hours. At 1905 hours, he advised the vehicle had just passed him south on Tucker Road and the driver had thrown a firecracker out of the driver window that struck Officer Long's patrol vehicle #173. I was in the area and saw the vehicle approaching the intersection of Tucker Road and Apison Pike. I activated my emergency equipment and asked the driver if he was the one throwing the fireworks. He yelled with his hands raised "Ok ok" and then sped off towards Apison Pike. I then initiated the pursuit.

The vehicle traveled west on Apison Pike. I could tell the vehicle had a drive out tag in the back left glass of the vehicle. That tag read 182042 out of the state of Oregon that had expired 8/13/2018. The driver then failed to yield to traffic turning north on Ooltewah Ringgold from Apison Pike. The vehicle passed many vehicles on the double yellow on Ooltewah Ringgold and Main Street. Hamilton County Deputies were stated at 5900 Main Street with spike strips. Officer Booth with Collegedale Police was with the County units. Officer Booth was getting out of the way of the driver approaching and lost his footing. Officer Booth needed to be transported to Erlanger East via Bradley County EMS after the pursuit for a knee injury.

The pursuit continued into Bradley County via Lee Highway. The vehicle stayed at a constant speed of 60-70mph. Bradley County Deputies attempted to use spike strips to subdue the suspect again, but the driver dodged them by entering another lane of traffic. The suspect then continued east on APD 40 in Bradley County.

The vehicle, due to traffic, then took a left on SW King st, went through the Bojangles parking lot and entered back west on APD40. The vehicle then turned right on SW King Street and then turned left in to the Captain D's parking lot. He exited the lot and took APD 40 west again. Myself and other Bradley units attempted to preform a rolling road block on the vehicle, but the vehicle turned left on Blackburn.

The vehicle turned left in to the Exxon Gas Station. I followed him around the gas pumps in the parking lot with Officer Long. The vehicle then struck head on Hamilton County's Deputy Ray's patrol vehicle attempting to flee from officers.

The now known suspect, Daniel Joseph Beniot, resisted officer's as we tried to take him into custody. Mr. Beniot was drive stunned/tased in attempt to reach his compliance to be taken in to custody. At 1925 hours, Mr. Beniot was placed in custody. A search of the vehicle was conducted. Inside the vehicle, was a lot fireworks in a brown paper bag. Also located in the car were two white pills bearing R180 on them in a sandwich type plastic bag.

He was looked at by EMS on scene and he advised that he wanted to be taken to the hospital. Officer Long transported Mr. Beniot to Erlanger East to be evaluated before seeing a magistrate at the Hamilton County Jail.

Mr. Beniot is being charged with two counts of Agg. Assault, Reckless Endangerment, Reckless Driving, Failure to Yield, Driving Unregistered vehicle, Felony Evading, Resisting Arrest and Simple Possession or Casual Exchange. His court date is set for 1/30/2018 at 1500 hours. The magistrate set his bonds at \$50,000.

The Tennessee Highway Patrol responded to the scene and worked the crash in Bradley County. The THP tow form has been added to this report.
